It will provide likeminded improvement leaders and facilitators with an opportunity to come together to learn, recharge their batteries, share stories about local improvement and connect with others.

Colleagues are doing fantastic work that is making a real difference to patients and staff. It takes sustained hard work and it can be lonely.
